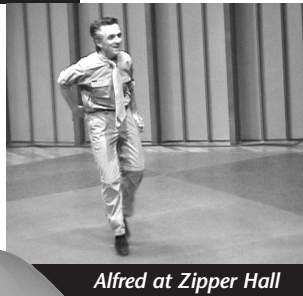


PLEASE BECOME PART OF OUR SUPPORT GROUP

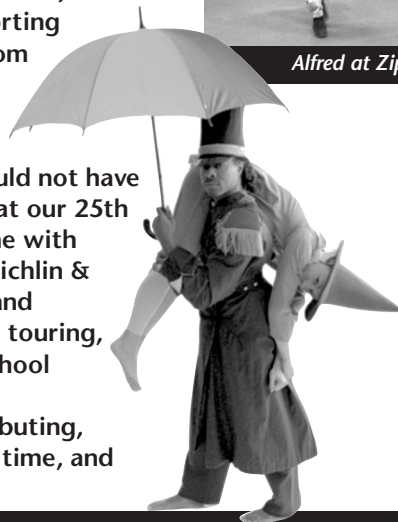
